

what you can bequeath

- All your assets
- A percentage of your assets
- A fixed amount
- The proceeds of your life insurance
- All or a percentage of the remainder of the estate after payment of debts and specific bequests
- An asset, such as a building, securities, a work of art, etc.

other types of planned giving

There are many types of donations you can make, during your lifetime or at the time of your death. To make a planned giving donation, you must look at your finances and determine the impact you would like to make. The REA Foundation accepts other types of donations, such as:

- Publicly traded securities
- Life insurance
- Charitable gift annuity or insured annuity
- Trust
- Residual interest
- RRSP/RRIF

a simple gesture, a powerful impact

Taking philanthropic action is a meaningful gesture that is often simpler than we think. By supporting physical rehabilitation, you are choosing to make a concrete contribution to improving the care offered, refining the technologies used and increasing clinical and research knowledge.

what to write

Here are some examples of formulations that could help you and your legal advisor, when the time comes for you to write your will.

Fixed amount or specific asset

I bequeath to the REA Foundation, a registered charitable organization, with its head office situated at 6300, Darlington Avenue, in Montreal, (a fixed amount, an RRSP account, a RRIF account or a specific asset) in support of its mission.

Residue of the estate

I bequeath to the REA Foundation, a registered charitable organization, with its head office situated at 6300, Darlington Avenue, in Montreal, (all or a percentage) of my estate, after settlement of my debts and specific bequests.

All assets

I bequeath to the REA Foundation, a registered charitable organization, with its head office situated at 6300, Darlington Avenue, in Montreal, all of my movable and immovable property.
